Barbecue Spare Ribs

Ingredients

- 3/4 cup dark brown sugar
- 1/2 cup soy sauce
- 1/2 cup ketchup
- 1/4 cup sherry vinegar
- 3 lbs. pork spareribs

Preparation

Combine the ketchup, soy sauce, sherry vinegar and brown sugar in a bowl. Whisk until the sugar is dissolved and evenly pour the marinade into large Ziploc bags (1 per rack of ribs). Add the ribs to each bag, zip it up and shake. Place in the refrigerator and allow to marinate 4 to 6 hours. Preheat oven to 325 degrees.

Place a roasting rack in a large roasting pan. Remove the ribs from the bags and pour all of the marinade into a saucepan. Bring the marinade to a boil over medium high heat, stirring the sauce constantly. Remove the sauce from the heat and allow to cool. Set a kitchen timer for 1 hour and 45 minutes. Place the ribs curve side up on the roasting pan and put them in the oven. Baste the ribs with the sauce every 15 - 20 minutes until complete.

Core Aeration

We're Scheduling for Fall Service Now!

Foot traffic. The heat of summer. Poor soil, Thatch buildup. All these things can put a great deal of stress on your lawn. Soil may become compacted causing moisture and important nutrients to run off and weakening the resistance of the grass blade to disease.

Penetration of compacted soil can be difficult without assistance. Fall aeration loosens the soil by pulling thousands of small plugs from the lawn allowing water and nutrients to more easily reach the root zone of your lawn and promote growth. Along with a greener lawn, aeration will help it to better withstand the rigors of winter.



Thousands of plugs approximately 1/2" wide x 3" deep are pulled from your lawn freeing roots to spread and allowing water and nutrients in.
